Issues & Challenges

ESG disclosure has moved from voluntary narrative to a condition of doing business — required by lenders, investors, listing rules and increasingly by clients at tender. The client was responding to each demand as it arrived, assembling every submission by hand from site records and spreadsheets, with no baseline against which progress could be shown.

- **No ESG baseline** — performance asserted in narrative rather than measured, so neither improvement nor targets could be evidenced.
- **Data scattered at source** — energy, water, waste and workforce data held locally by site and vendor, reassembled manually for every disclosure.
- **Framework fragmentation** — GRI, LEED, TCFD and lender questionnaires each answered separately from the same underlying facts.
- **Climate risk unquantified** — physical and transition exposure understood qualitatively, with no financial impact attached and nothing disclosure-ready.

Service Offerings Delivered

Energica delivered the full four-stage journey on the Sustainzy platform — measure, monitor, report — taking the client from ad hoc response to a governed reporting cycle built on one baseline and one governed data set.

- **Stage 01 — Sustainable strategy** — ESG readiness assessment and materiality via ESG Olive, establishing the baseline and the value case.
- **Stage 02 — SDG & ESG roadmap** — a sequenced blueprint with targets, owners and ESG risk screening.
- **Stage 03 — Climate risk** — Clima Watch quantifies physical and transition risk and prepares nature-related financial disclosure.
- **Stage 04 — Sustainability reporting** — Sustainzy automates capture and multi-framework reporting, with Sustainzy-LEED carrying the accreditation pathway.
